CloudBerry S3 Explorer

CloudBerry Explorer makes managing files in Amazon S3 storage EASY. By providing a user interface to Amazon S3 accounts, files, and buckets, CloudBerry lets you manage your files on cloud just as you would on your own local computer.

Features

- Register and connect to any number of Amazon S3 accounts
- Work with any number of Amazon S3 accounts simultaneously
- Copy files between S3 accounts
- Share buckets and files on Amazon S3 with other users
- Create, browse, and delete S3 buckets
- Copy and move files between Amazon S3 and your local computer

- Set up file access permissions (ACL)

- Automate common tasks with Microsoft PowerShell
- Generate external URLs
- Support for time limited or signed URLs
- Support for MD5 to ensure files are not corrupted while transferred to S3

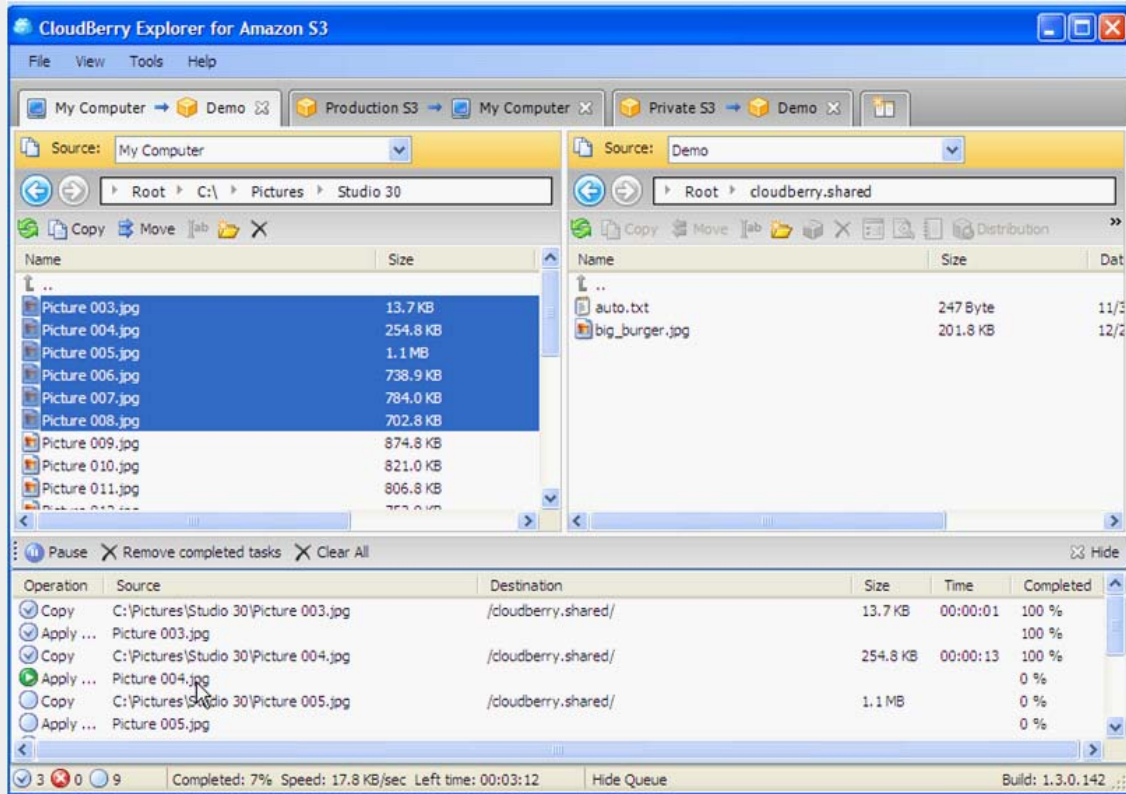

CloudBerry Explorer allows you to copy files in the background, you can turn to other tasks while copy process is running. You can also pause/ resume copy process and review copy queue for errors.



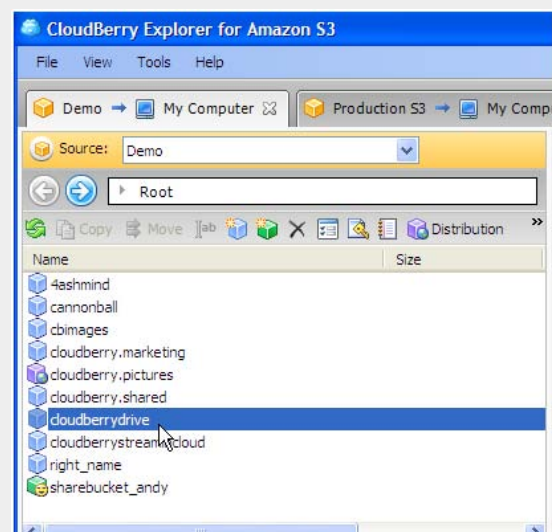
Register Multiple S3 Accounts

CloudBerry Explorer allows you to register as many Amazon S3 accounts as you like



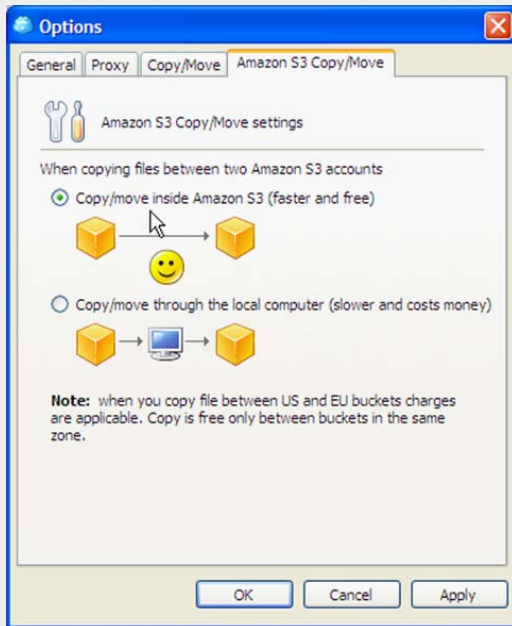
Browse S3 Buckets

CloudBerry Explorer allows you to browse contents of your S3 buckets. Create new buckets and folders and rename files.



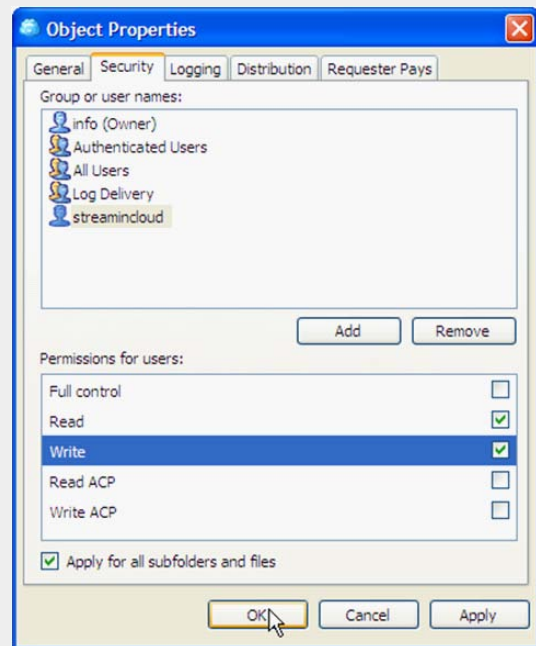
Copy Files between S3 Accounts

CloudBerry Explorer allows you to copy files in the background, you can turn to other tasks while copy process is running. You can also pause/resume copy process and review copy queue for errors.



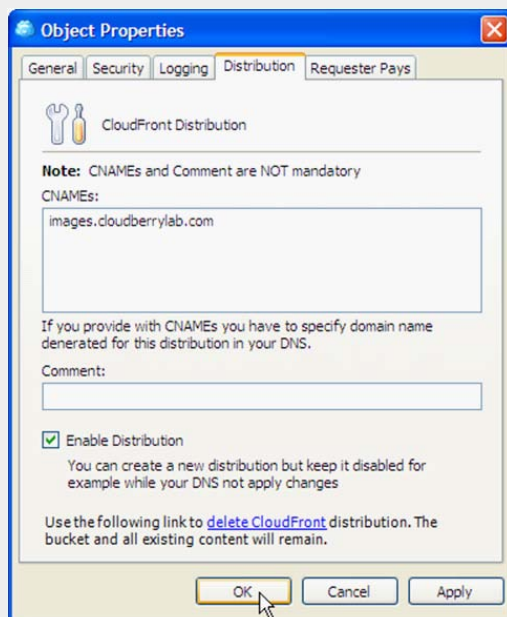
Setup Access Control List (ACL)

CloudBerry Explorer allows you to copy files in the background, you can turn to other tasks while copy process is running. You can also pause/resume copy process and review copy queue for errors.



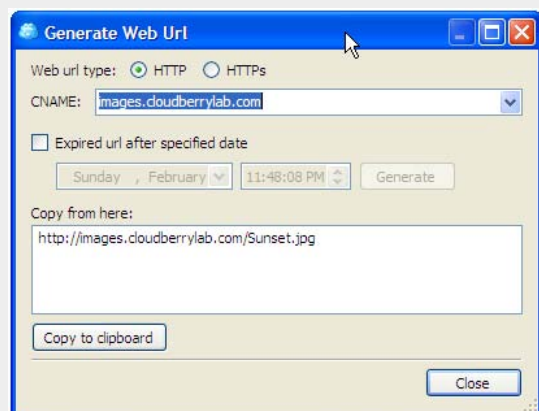
Configuring CloudFront Distribution

CloudBerry Explorer allows you to configure Amazon CloudFront service in a matter of minutes. Just select a bucket and click a button on the toolbar.



Generating Web URL

CloudBerry Explorer allows you to generate URL for single or multiple objects. You can also generate time limited URLs that will expire at a predefined time. You can also specify CNAMEs to make your URLs look nicer.
